## 1) #114-22: Nelson Riley III/ Nelson Riley IV (owner/applicant)

Continuation of Conditional Use & Site Plan review for a multi-family P.U.D. development of 50 two-bedroom units with 10 buildings each containing 4 to 6 dwelling units located at Parcel #100-5575 Waterbury-Stowe Road, near the intersection of Spruce Haven Rd and Route 100. (RT100/CNS)

The public hearing was continued to April 19th, at 6:30 p.m.

## 2) #013-23 Neal and Sara Graves (owner/applicant)

Site Plan, Conditional Use review and waiver request to convert a 2-story commercial building into an 8-room boarding house with a 1-bedroom apartment. (VCOM).

- 1. DRB members expressed concerns:
  - a. The parking spaces are not ideal, how will residents maneuver in and out of spaces
  - b. Gravel parking would be difficult with this many parking spaces
  - c. The access to the community kitchen is from the outside
  - d. Where will the community dumpster be located
  - e. Lack of a sprinkler system (not required by this use)
  - f. Water allocation has not been approved by the Town
  - g. Lighting should be indicated on the revised plan.
  - h. Review by the Fire Marshall. Plans for egress.

The DRB requested a revised site plan and answers to the above concerns.

Appeal of a Zoning Administrator's denial of application #004-23 to construct a single-family house at 35 Sunset Dr. (TCOM zoning district)
